High Performance Building and Sustainable Design

The Gerald D. Hines College of Architecture, University of Houston invites applications for a full-time, tenure-track studio teaching position with an emphasis on high performance building and/or sustainable design at the rank of Assistant or Associate Professor.

As an energy capital and the fourth largest city in the United States, Houston offers a unique environment to investigate building performance and sustainable design. The University of Houston is located within a large dynamic metropolitan area and is among the most diverse universities in the country. The Gerald D. Hines College of Architecture takes advantage of this unique setting by offering a comprehensive integration of programs in architecture, industrial design and space architecture (SICSA). The faculty and students are actively involved in architectural practice, research, and urban issues. With the recently completed Burdette Keeland Design Exploration Center, investigations of computer fabrication, prototyping, and design-build programs are now facilitated with advanced machinery.

The successful candidate will contribute in defining the direction for the integration of sustainable design throughout undergraduate and graduate design studios. The candidate shall pursue creative scholarship through teaching, practice, and/or research.

The candidate should be qualified to teach upper level design studios, integrate high performance and sustainable design principles into design curricula, conduct lecture or seminar courses, and promote sustainable strategies as responsible design. Candidates must have a masters degree in architecture. Professional experience, history of competitive design awards and publications, previous teaching experience, and/or professional licensure is preferred.
